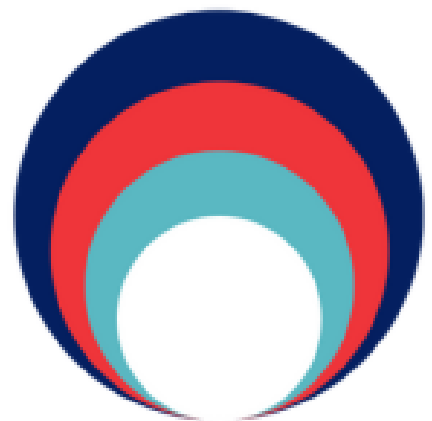

What does it look like?

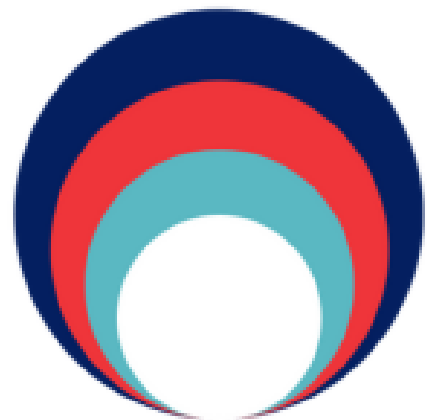
Interactive virtual events	Facilitated discussion to start the conversation about how developing and deepening human skills creates the conditions for success in the long-term.
